Sugar Free Weekend Retreat

Since 1994, the American Diabetes Association has provided children with diabetes and their families the opportunity to come together for a fun-filled educational weekend retreat where special memories are created to last a lifetime. It is held each year in the fall at Camp Arrowhead in Lewes, Delaware.

Kids with diabetes are in the minority

.....except at the American Diabetes Association's Sugar Free Weekend Retreat where children with diabetes are surrounded by other children just like them. Through the expert guidance of Certified Diabetes Educators, Physician, Nurses, and volunteers, children and parents are offered seminars on topics such as: nutrition, exercise, carbohydrate counting, insulin therapies, insulin pump technology and the psycho-social aspects of having diabetes. They are also encouraged to develop skills for managing their diabetes as well as interacting with children on a social level through crafts, and activities such as rock climbing, archery, the high ropes course and swimming. Each year, families return to share ideas that help us fight the battle of diabetes in our community. The number one benefit both retreaters and parents express is the ability to connect with a group where everyone has diabetes and the feelings of isolation are minimized.

Directions to Camp Arrowhead: From North-West: After Bay Bridge, turn right to Rte. 50. Take Rte. 50 to Rte. 404 and turn left. Take Denton bypass to Rte. 16. Turn left and continue until you reach Rte. 1. Turn right and follow Rte. 1 to Rehoboth Beach. Turn right at Rte. 24, travel approx. 3 miles, across stone bridge, Eugene Bookhammer Bridge. From the North: Drive South on Rte. 1 to Rte. 24. Travel approximately 3 miles, across stone bridge, Eugene Bookhammer Bridge. From the Eugene Bookhammer Bridge: At the next intersection, turn left onto Rte. 279, Camp Arrowhead Rd. Stay left at Y (says no outlet) Travel 4 miles. After you pass West Bay Park, Camp Arrowhead is the next left. (Approx. 4 miles from intersection turn).
